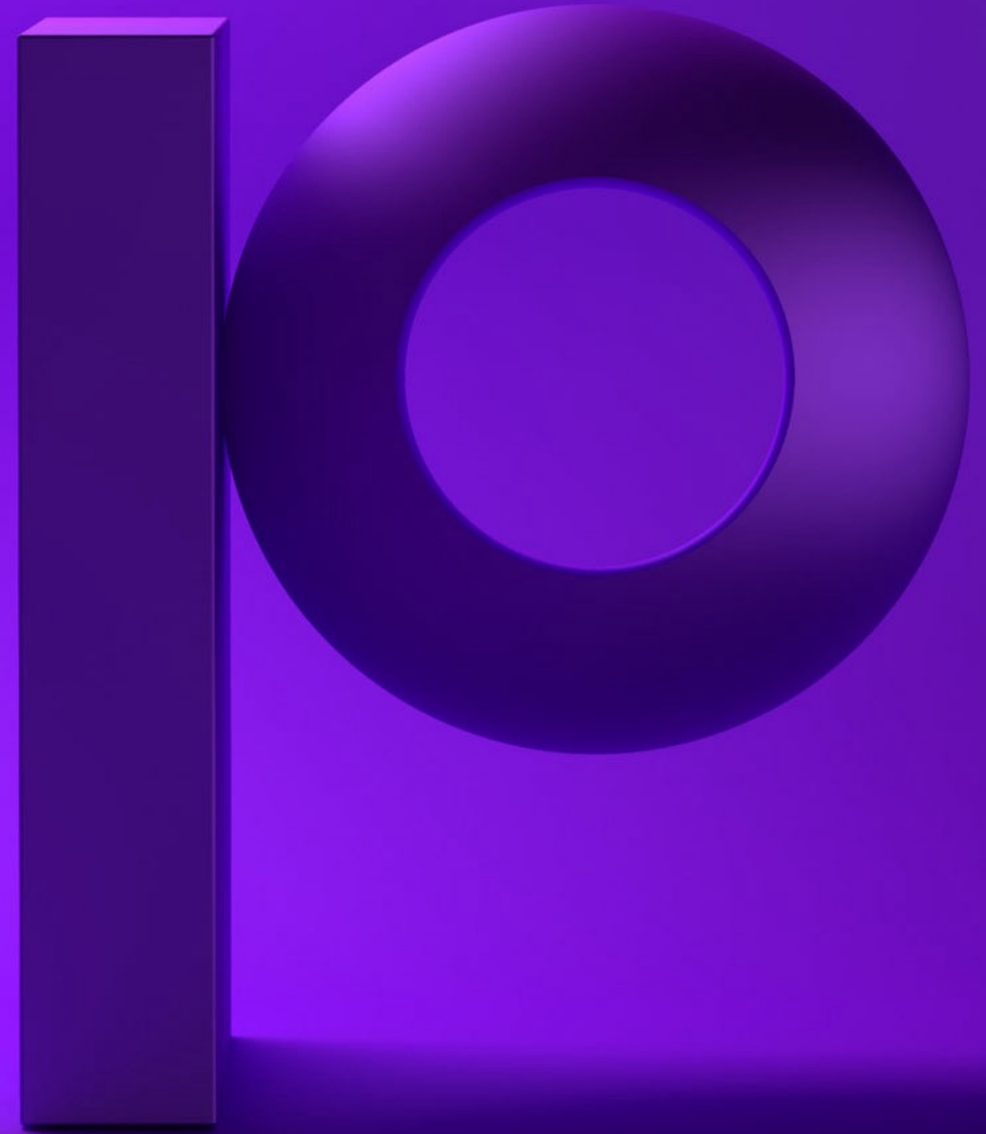

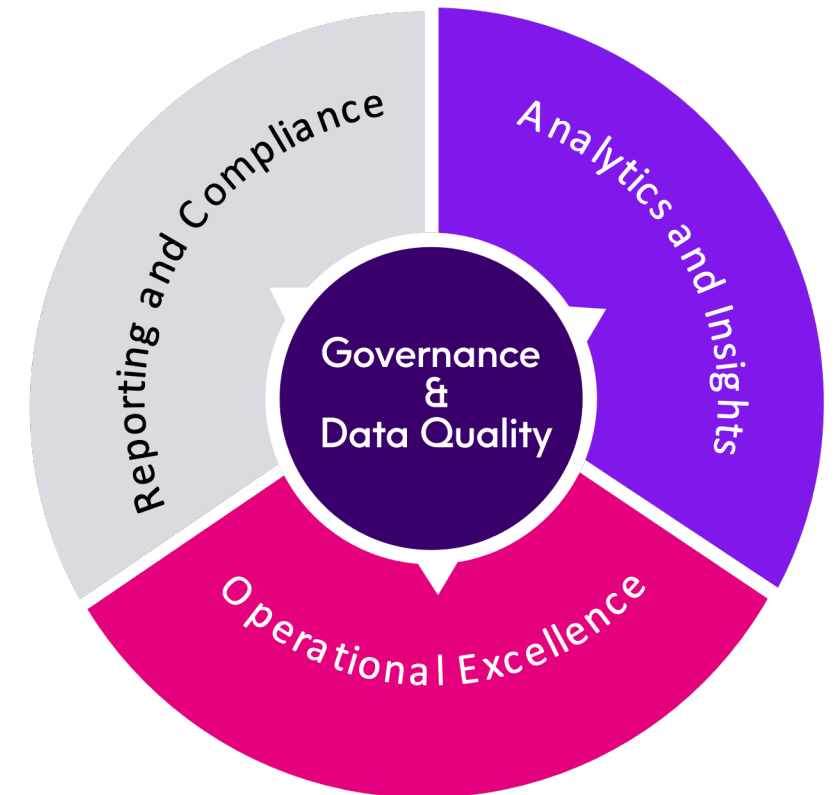


The Point of Governance is NOT Governance

The most common mistake we make is how we position and talk about governance.



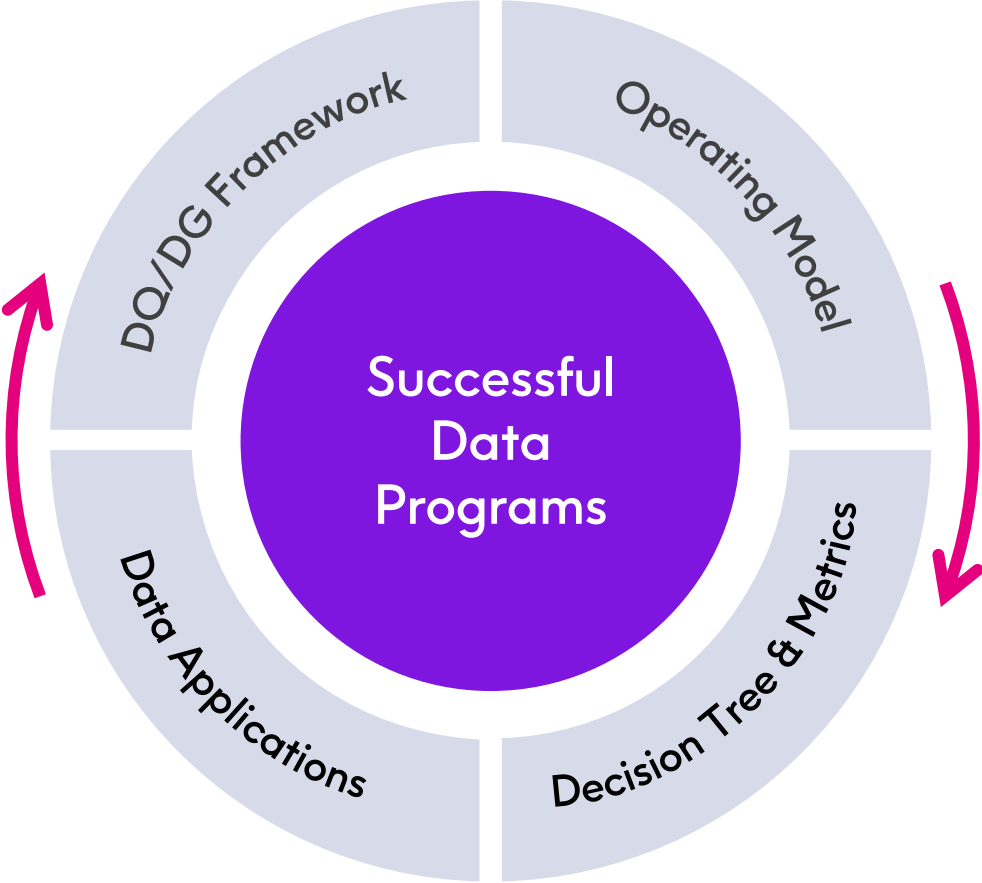

Data Architecture and Applications that are directly aligned to business objectives, integrate seamlessly, scale and promote data collaboration, efficiency and literacy

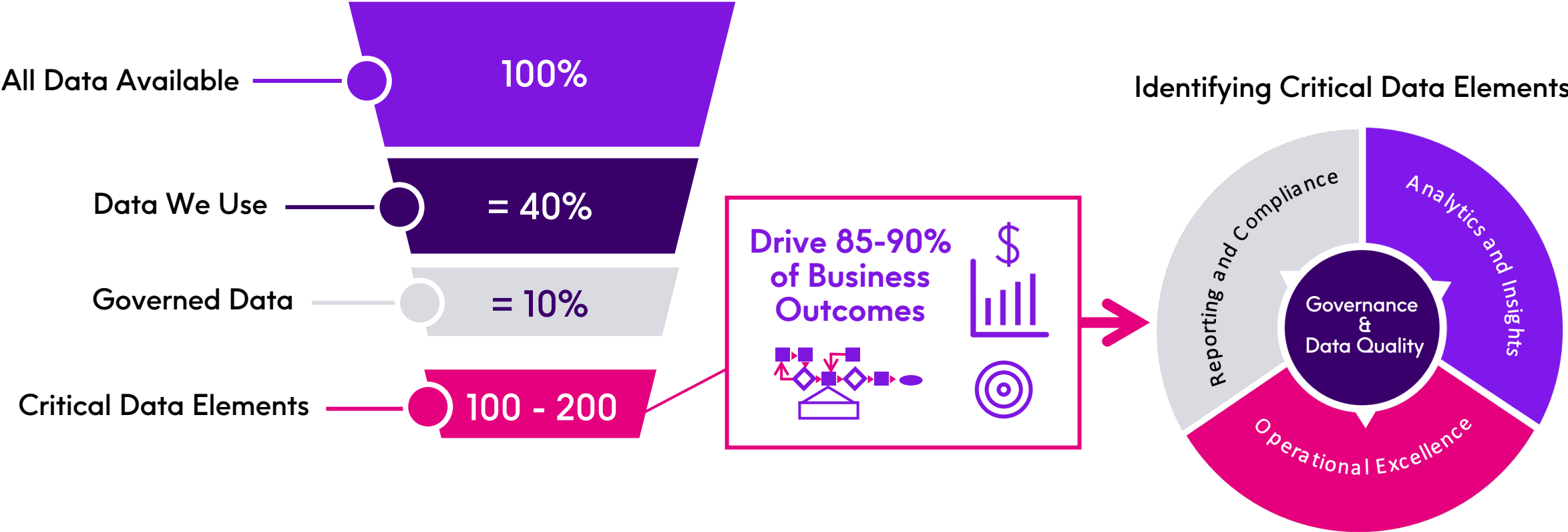


Business accountability for data with 'fit for purpose' operating models/processes and a complementary org construct to provide a structured & repeatable process for sustained data integrity and value creation

Gaining Leadership Support for Data Governance

Definitions

- **Data Governance** – The execution and enforcement of authority over data.
- **Data Stewardship** – Formal accountability for data.
- **Data Steward** – A person held formally accountable for their relationship to the data.
- **Metadata** – Data that improves both the **business and technical understanding** of the data.
- **Metadata Governance** – The execution and enforcement of authority over metadata.
- **Metadata Steward** – A person held formally accountable for their relationship to the metadata.

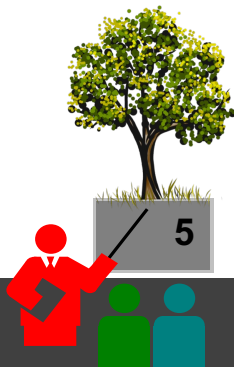

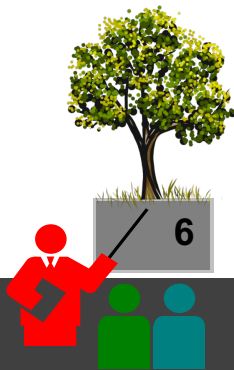

 - Select From Industry Best Practice
 - Criteria to Determine Best Practice
 - What Can Be Leveraged
 - Where There is Opportunity to Improve



Gaining Leadership Support for Data Governance

The Best of Best Practices

- Industry Best Practices
 - Senior Leadership Support, Sponsor, and Understand
 - Resources are Allocated to Administer the Program – On an On-Going Basis
 - Policy, Guidelines, Frameworks, Standards are Approved and Enforced
 - Goals, Scope, Expectation, Roles, Measures are Defined and Communicated
 - Data is Governed Consistently Across the Organization

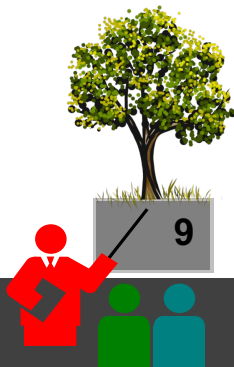
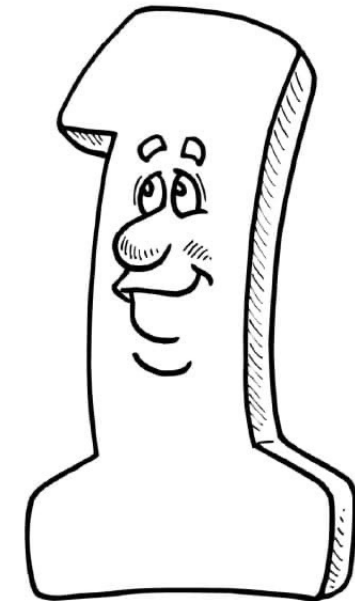

 - Focus Actions on Gaining Support, Sponsorship, and Understanding



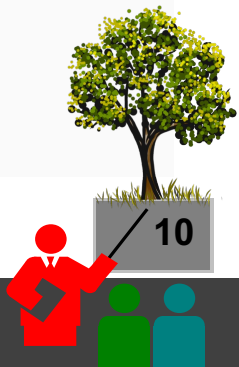

 - Deploy a Data Documentation Platform



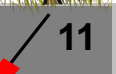
